



## **Guidelines Around Reopening**

The OZCF Board has discussed the numerous issues around reopening the ZRCC facilities and how we plan to manage it.

Keeping in mind the prime importance of the safety of all members, the Board has taken the decision that the ZRCC facilities shall remain closed for **ALL** summer events **except for important religious events and funerals**. It is important to note that these gatherings will have minimal numbers as we must not only meet Halton Region guidelines but those of the Ministry of Health's "Religious Services, Rites or Ceremonies" document, while also respecting numbers which Mobeds are comfortable with.

- No communion / navjote events, birthday celebration events, etc.
  - No gathering at halls and grounds
  - No community events – Cricket / Scouts / Seniors events / Sports / etc.
  - No rental for hall until further notice
  - Prayer Room will remain closed till further notice

- Only gradual opening for Religious events scheduled for the year. A separate notification on religious events and guidelines to be followed will be communicated over the next few days.
  - On July 1<sup>st</sup>, we will hold the Maidhyoshem Gahambar. There will be no community gathering; the Jashan ceremony will be broadcast live. An emailer will be sent out separately within the next couple of days.
  - Hall will be available for performing Obituary ceremonies. Immediate family, up to maximum of 10 people, will be allowed inside.

The Board will update the Guidelines, Plans and Announcements as per new guidance from the Government.

It is imperative that members keep abreast of the changing directives on congregating during the current COVID-19 pandemic. The Board will notify the community of any changes, as they arise.

We understand the need to come out and socialize with other members, however, we ask that all members continue exercising caution. While the decision to venture out rests with members, the Board strongly recommends seniors to remain in the safety of their homes.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR INDIVIDUAL PRAYER VISIT AT ZRCC**

- 1. Ensure Face Mask and Gloves are on when entering the ZRCC facility**
- 2. Complete and Hand over the COVID-19 screen check sheet to the volunteer (1 for each member present)**
- 3. Take a number the volunteer gives you**
- 4. Park and remain in your vehicle until your number is called (no socializing in the parking lot)**
- 5. When your # is called, exit your car and enter the Prayer Hall**
- 6. If you wish to wash your hands/face, bring your own water bottle**
- 7. Should you wish to light a Divo, please ask the volunteer present to light it for you**
- 8. Sukhad needs to be bought from OZCF only and the volunteer will make the offering to the holy fire**
- 9. Please put money in the donation box (we ask for your generosity)**
- 10. Stand and Pray in the designated spot duly marked on the floor**
- 11. Please bring your own Prayer Books**
- 12. We ask that you remain for only 5 minutes (based on the number of people waiting to give others a chance to pray as well)**
- 13. When you have finished praying, we ask that you leave the premises immediately to make room for others who are waiting (no socializing in the parking lot)**
