The renter will provide the OZCF with proof of such insurance with OZCF mentioned in the policy as an Additional Insured at the time of entering into this agreement. ***If alcohol is being served, it must be mentioned when applying for the policy.*** A copy of the insurance policy, Special Occasion Permit (SOP) from the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario and the renter's completed application (available online) for insurance must be provided to OZCF at the time of paying the rental charges.

Zarir's son Jasper Cooper collected the award on his behalf. Having volunteers like Zarir helps us ensure our sessions are covered and we continue to receive regular revenue from Delta Bingo.

Another committee that Zarir is an integral part of is the Facilities Management Committee. They look after everything from basic stuff like ensuring we have enough supply of garbage bags and bathroom tissues to getting the water tank filled and septic tank emptied regularly to working with external contractors for pest control around the property, fixing leaks in our water tank or repairing the pillars outside the hall. The FMC team looks after this aspect, and Zarir is an integral part of that team. Earlier this year we installed automatic doors and equipped the facilities with remote unlocking and locking capabilities, so someone doesn't have to physically come lock/unlock the hall when there are early morning prayers or a private

event ending late at night. Zarir worked with the contractor to set up the system and then trained those that have access to the system on how to use it. Zarir is also one of the 2 volunteers we have trained to perform our monthly water testing that is required by the Town of Oakville. The Board and OZCF feel honored to recognize Zarir for his immense voluntary contributions.
